

## **JAIF, KAIF to Stage Japan-Korea Nuclear Industrial Seminar in Pusan**

**On October 29 and 30, the Korea Atomic Industrial Forum (KAIF) and the Japan Atomic Industrial Forum (JAIF) will jointly sponsor the 29th Japan-Korea Nuclear Industrial Seminar in the city of Pusan in South Korea. The total program, including field trips, will last seven days, from October 28 to November 3.**

The seminar has been held since 1979, alternately in Japan and Korea, in order to provide opportunities for information to be exchanged on nuclear development and use. This time there will be presentations and discussions on seven subjects: (1) the design, manufacture and construction of nuclear power plants (NPPs), (2) radwaste and the environment, (3) managing the aging of NPPs, (4) developing human resources for the maintenance of NPPs, (5) medium- and small-size reactors and future reactors, (6) effects of the July 16, 2007, earthquake on the Kashiwazaki Kariwa NPS, and seismic design and structure, and (7) feedback on experience from reactor operations and optimization of maintenance.

After the seminar, the participants are to visit Doosan Heavy Industries' Changwon Plant, the medium- and low-level radioactive waste site at Gyeongju, and the Ulchin NPS.
