

Russo-Japanese Summit: Cooperation on Climate Change Framework

From April 25 to 27, Japanese Prime Minister Yasuo Fukuda made an unofficial visit to Russia, where he met with President Vladimir Putin and First Deputy Prime Minister, President-elect Dmitry Medvedev.

In Fukuda's discussions with Medvedev, who will assume the Russian presidency on May 7, the two leaders agreed to cooperate and coordinate their efforts on the new post-2013 framework on climate change. Medvedev also told Fukuda that he would cooperate with Japan for the success of the upcoming 2008 G-8 Summit in Japan, to be held from July 7 to 9, 2008.
