

JAEA and KAERI Inked New Agreement on Cooperation

On September 4, the Japan Atomic Energy Agency (JAEA) signed an agreement with the Korea Atomic Energy Research Institute (KAERI) relating to cooperation in research fields of the peaceful atomic energy utilization.

The new fields of cooperation agreement are broad ranged comprising NPP safety and radiation protection, environmental monitoring, particle-beam science and technology, the geological disposal of high-level radioactive wastes (HLW), the development of fuel and materials, and the utilization and operation of research and demonstration reactors. Both institutions will thus deepen their level of cooperation with each other to an unprecedented degree.
