

NISA Reports NSC : TEPCO's Report on Kashiwazaki-Kariwa-7 NPS "Appropriate"

On October 3rd, the Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency (NISA) presented to the Nuclear Safety Commission (NSC) a report on its evaluation of a report submitted by the Tokyo Electric Power Co. (TEPCO) on September 19. NISA assessed that TEPCO's report was "appropriate".

In the TEPCO report, the results of its own inspections and assessments of equipments, buildings and other structures at the Kashiwazaki-Kariwa-7 NPS after the devastating Niigata Chuetsu Offshore Earthquake of July 16, 2007 are described.
