

Former Prime Minister Nakasone Receives "Atoms for Peace" Prize

On October 16, the World Council of Nuclear Workers and the Japanese NPO International Institute for Sustainable Peace (IISP) announced the awarding of the second "Atoms for Peace" prize to Japan's former Prime Minister Yasuhiro Nakasone. Nakasone was prime minister of Japan for almost five years between 1982 and 1987. He is now 90 years old.

The previous "Atoms for Peace" prize – the inaugural prize – was awarded to Dr. Mohamed ElBaradei, the current IAEA Director General.
