

Organo Corporation to Cultivate U.S. NPP Market

On November 11, Organo Corporation announced its signing of a licensing contract to supply its technology to Graver Water Systems, a U.S. water-processing company. The move was made to expand the company's water-processing business aimed at nuclear power plants (NPPs) in the US.

The kinds of technology to be licensed include hollow-tube film-type condensate filters, condensate demineralizers, nuclear reactor water-clarification systems and fuel pool water-clarification systems. Organo has demonstrated the viability of all these technologies in the Japanese market.
