

Seventh Meeting on Japan-Russia Nuclear Cooperation Agreement Held in Tokyo

On November 18 and 19, the seventh meeting to discuss the Japan-Russia Nuclear Cooperation Agreement was held in Tokyo, with both negotiating parties continuing to discuss the nature of the agreement.

The Japanese delegation to the meeting was headed by Director-general Toshio Sano of the Disarmament, Nonproliferation and Science Department, part of the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA), and the Russian delegation by Director M. N. Lysenko of the Department of International Cooperation, part of the Russian Nuclear Energy State Corporation (Rosatom).
