

ITER Board Meets in France, Issuing Communiqué

An ITER Board of Directors meeting was held on November 19 and 20 in Cadarache, France, where the International Thermonuclear Experimental Reactor (ITER) is to be constructed. In a joint communiqué entitled “Global Management of Science,” the participating members restated that ITER was the most significant current project seeking to demonstrate the feasibility of a safe, sustainable, future energy source.

The Japanese representative to the meeting was Deputy Minister Toichi Sakata of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).
