Message from the Chairman

The confidence of the Japanese public in nuclear energy has been severely shaken owing to the accident that occurred at the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station (NPS) on March 11, 2011. At present, more than anything else, it is necessary to put the recovery of damage-stricken Fukushima on a firm footing. Meanwhile, the damage to the power station has brought renewed attention to the importance of securing a stable supply of electricity.

Predicated on safety, nuclear energy continues to be an important power source within Japan's overall energy policy, given the country's lack of natural resources. Viewed internationally, it is important for countries promoting the use of nuclear power to share their experiences and knowledge in the pursuit of the safe utilization of this energy source.

The Japan Atomic Industrial Forum, Inc. (JAIF) will work toward the restoration of public trust in nuclear power, again predicated on safety, while promoting the understanding of nuclear energy, including the use of radiation. It will also carry out various activities contributing to the realization of safe nuclear power through international exchanges, keeping an eye on the ever-changing worldwide situation surrounding nuclear energy.

Diversity

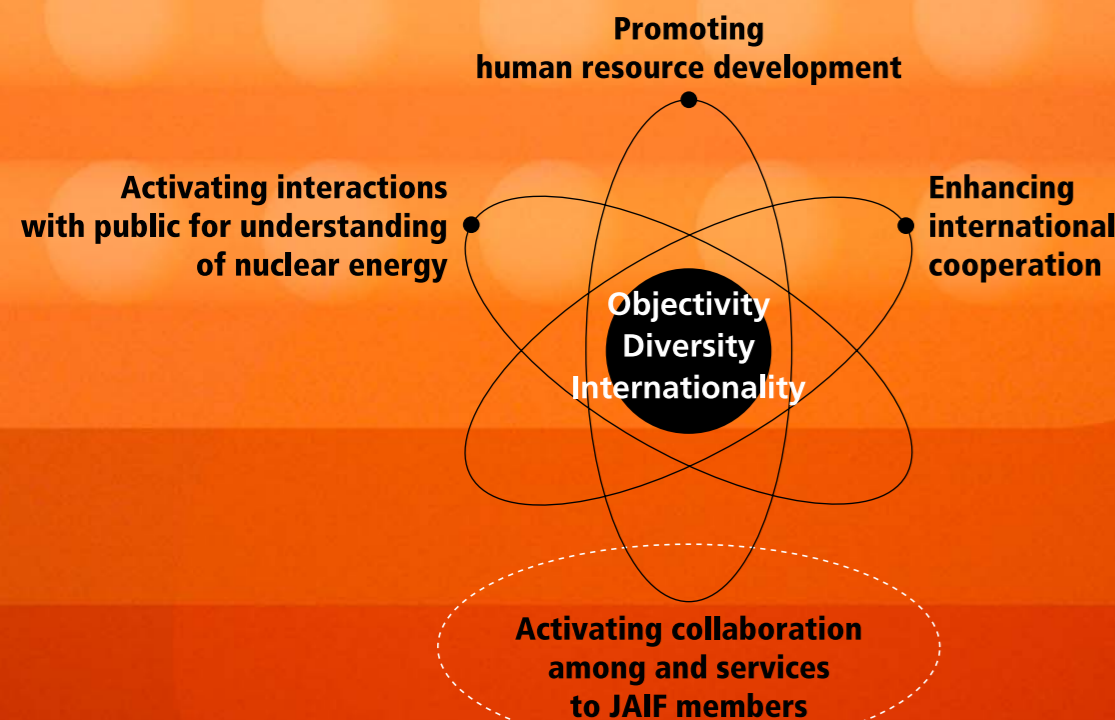

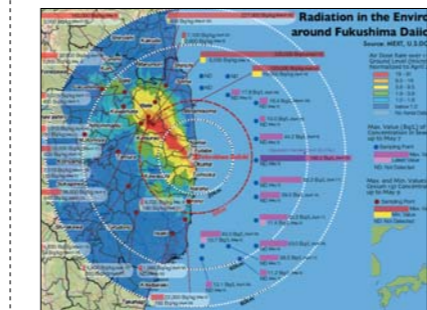
