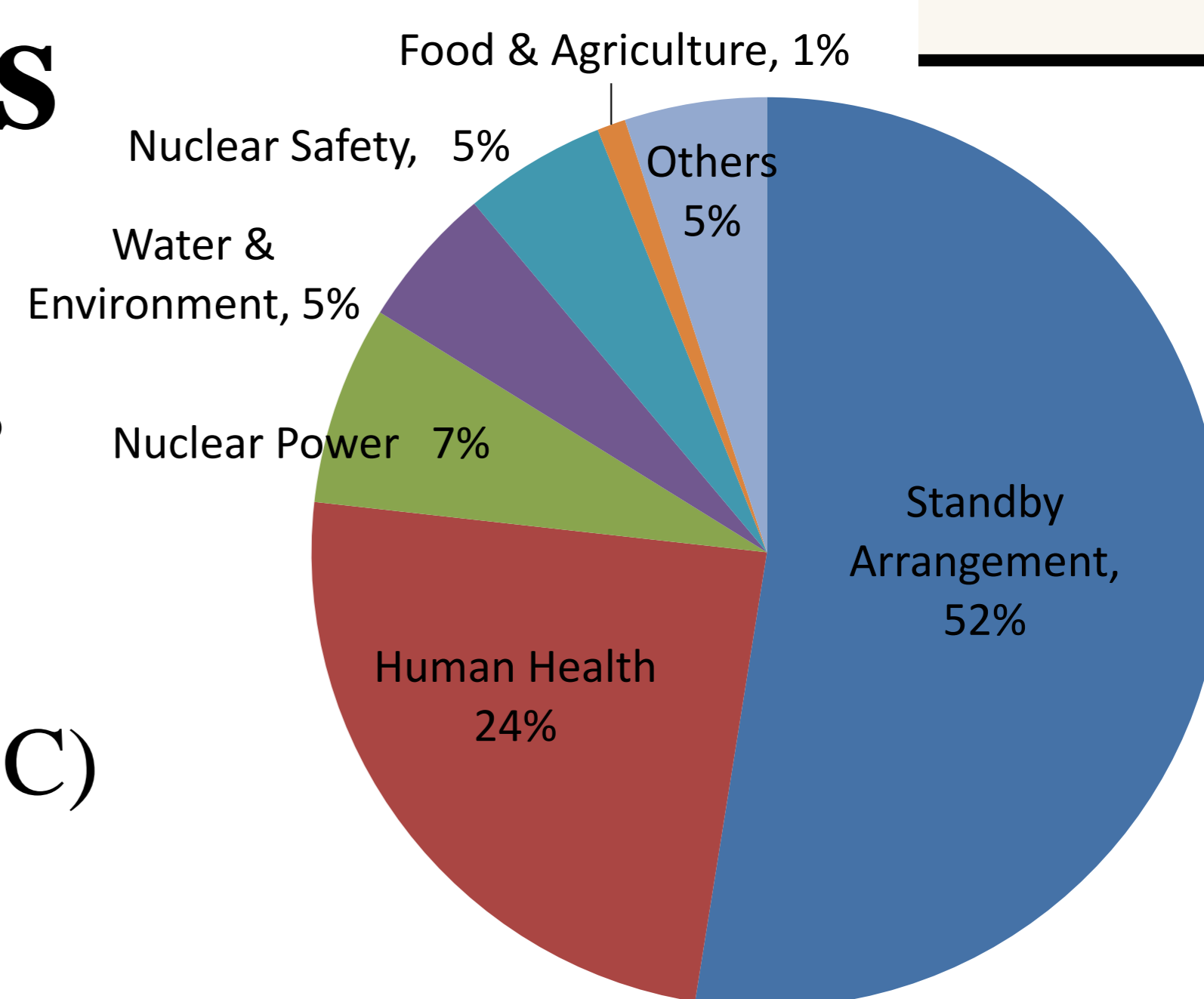

- Total contribution: **37.5 million** US dollars  
(**21% of total PUI contribution**)
- Total Projects: **73** (64 TC, 9 NA, 9 NE, 2 MT, 1 DGOC)
