
Futaba-gun and Okuma Town as Seen Today by Local Government Staff

Outline of Okuma Town


Located in the central part of Hamadori, the coastal area of Fukushima Prefecture, Okuma has a population of 11,501 (March 11, 2011) and an area of 78.7 km2. (The area enclosed by the Yamanote "Loop" Line in Tokyo is 63 km2.)
Local products include pears and kiwis, wine made from them, and farm-raised flounder.

■ Tokyo Electric Power Co.'s Fukushima-Daiichi-1 through -4 Nuclear Power Plants were sited under an initiative of the national government and Fukushima Prefecture. Unit 1 commenced operation in March 1971.







Location of Okuma






