## Requirements for Sustaining Nuclear Power

- (1) <u>Political commitment (national government, municipalities)</u>
- = Common recognition that nuclear power is especially necessary for Japan's national strength and interests, and for regional development
  - → To be reflected in all nuclear-related systems designs
- Rebuilding a system to promote nuclear energy through unified public and private sector efforts
- (2) Secure financing environment
- = Is it possible to ensure long-term, stable funding in the face of challenges of liberalization? [OR: Is it possible to ensure long-term, stable funding consistent with the principles of liberalization?]
- Establishing a system to share risks/costs between the public and private sectors
- (3) Technological metabolism
- = Continual innovation at technological sites
- Making appropriate changes to focuses of regulatory activities
- Clear distinction between business regulation and safety regulation -- Major revisions to the Reactor Regulation Law
